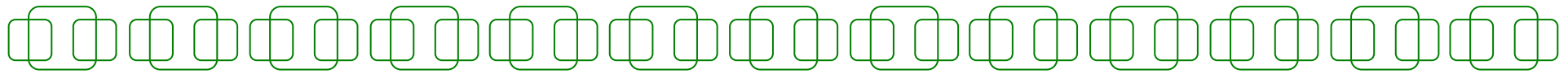
### M ED in READING AND LITERACY DEGREE ADMITS STUDENTS IN SEPTEMBER

Applicants to the Endicott M ED Reading Program are required to submit the following items:

- Endicott College Graduate Application for admission
- \$100.00 Non-refundable application fee to PRISM Educational Consultants
- statement of professional goals,
- Official transcript from your baccalaureate degree granting college or university. The transcript must indicate degree received and the date of graduation. The official transcript must be sent directly from the institution to PRISM Educational Consultants, Inc. 85 Forest Drive, Bridgewater, MA 02324 Att: Maura
- a passing score on the Communication & Literacy test
- a copy of all Massachusetts Licenses
- Official score of the GRE or MAT is required for all applicants to this program (unless this is a second Master's). This should be sent directly to Endicott College's graduate admissions office. A copy of your scores should also be sent directly to the Jenmarc-Prism office to become part of your file.
- TWO (2) letters of recommendation from individuals under whom the applicant has studied or under whose supervision s/he has worked in a professional capacity

**Pre-Requisite: Candidates for this program must hold at least an Initial License in a teaching field and have at least one year of teaching experience under that license.**
