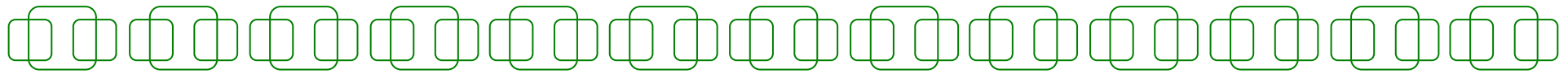

Applicants to the ENDICOTT M ED in SPEC NEEDS Program are required to submit the following:

- Endicott College Graduate Application for admission
- \$50.00 Non-refundable application fee to Endicott College
- Official transcript from your baccalaureate degree granting college or university. The transcript must indicate degree received and the date of graduation. The official transcript must be sent directly from the institution to Jenmarc-Prism, Education Consultants, PO Box 663, Brockton, MA 02303-0663, Attn: M Ed Director
- Official score of the GRE or MAT is required for all applicants to this program (unless this is a second Master's). This should be sent directly to Endicott College's graduate admissions office. A copy of your scores should also be sent directly to the Jenmarc-Prism office to become part of your file.
- Copies: MTEL scores/Teacher License
- Two (2) letters of recommendation from individuals under whom the applicant has studied or under whose supervision s/he has worked in a professional capacity. Please use the Endicott College Letter of Recommendation Forms in the application packet and submit any attached narrative portions on official letterhead.
- A statement of your professional goals.
