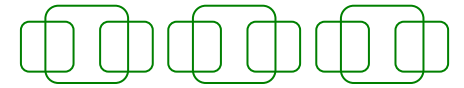
Important to Know

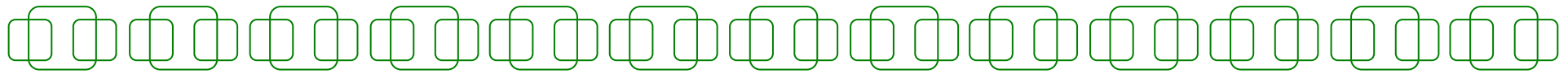

Applicants to the ENDICOTT COLLEGE M ED Program are required to submit the following:

- Endicott College Graduate Application for admission
- \$50.00 Non-refundable application fee to Endicott College
- Official transcript from your baccalaureate degree-granting college or university. The transcript must indicate degree received and the date of graduation. The official transcript must be sent directly from the institution to Jon L Jenmarc-Prism, Educ Consultants, PO Box 663, Brockton, MA 02303-0663 ATT: M Ed Director
- Official score of the GRE or MAT is required for all applicants to the M ED program. This should be sent directly to Endicott College's graduate admissions office. **A copy of your scores should also be sent directly to the Jenmarc office to become part of your file.**
- Copy of current Teacher License (even though this is a *non-license* program.)
- Two (2) letters of recommendation from individuals under whom the applicant has studied or under whose supervision s/he has worked in a professional capacity. Please use the Endicott College Letter of Recommendation Forms in the application packet and submit any attached narrative portions on official letterhead.
- A statement of Professional Goals
